

eligibility

Applicants must be:

NREIP

Enrolled at a four-year U.S. college or university deemed accredited by the U.S. Department of Education; students attending two-year colleges who are majoring in a field of research that is of interest to participating laboratories and who meet the credit-hour requirements may be eligible at a laboratory's discretion

University sophomores, juniors, seniors or graduate students; freshmen are eligible to apply if they have reached the credit level of a sophomore before starting the internship

Enrolled in a program of study that is relevant to the research interests of the participating laboratories

U.S. citizens; permanent residents will be considered by some of the participating laboratories

SEAP

Rising 10th through 12th graders

Must be 16 years old at time of application

U.S. citizens; permanent residents will be considered by some of the participating laboratories

award duration

Participants will spend a continuous 10 weeks (NREIP) or 8 weeks (SEAP) during the summer

stipends

SEAP: \$3,500 (new intern), \$4,000 (returning)

NREIP: \$7,000 (new intern), \$8,500 (returning)

\$11,000 (graduate student)

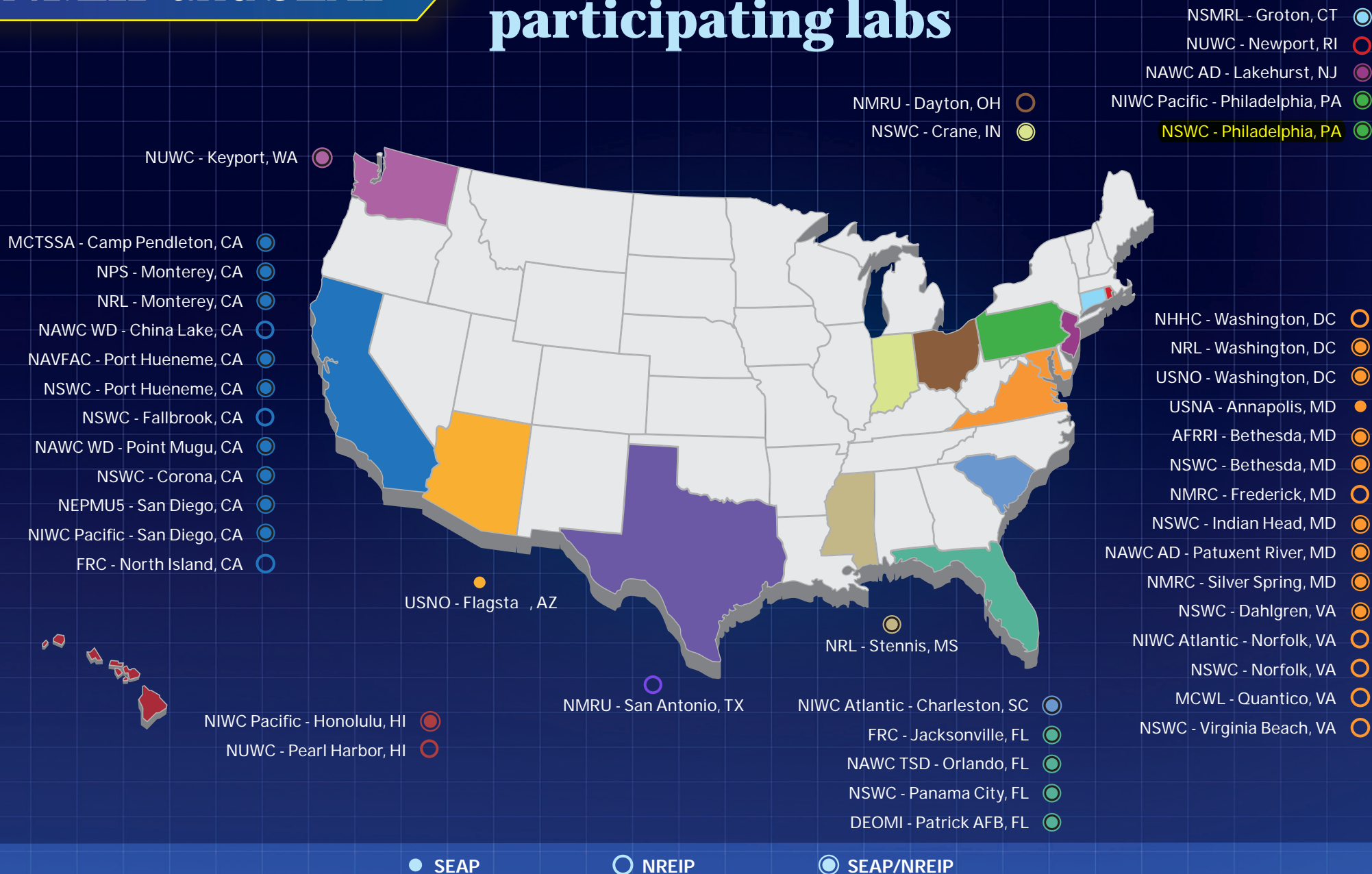
