CDR Shea is a native of Jupiter, FL. He graduated with honors from Deland High School in 1985. He enlisted in the Navy in 1985 and completed Naval Nuclear Power Training in 1986.

While enlisted he advanced to the rank of Electronics Technician Chief Petty Officer and served on the following submarines, USS STONEWALL JACKSON (SSBN 634), USS SEAWOLF (SSN 21), USS FINBACK (SSN 670) and USS RHODE ISLAND (SSBN 740). He also completed an instructor tour at NPTU CHARLESTON on the MTS-635.

CDR Shea was commissioned as a Nuclear Limited Duty Officer in 1999. His service as a commissioned officer included sea tours aboard USS THEODORE ROOSEVELT (CVN 71) and two tours aboard USS HARRY S. TRUMAN (CVN 75).

Ashore he served as Hull Division Officer and then Quality Assurance Officer at TRF Kings Bay. He served an overseas tour in Naples Italy as the Assistant Nuclear Power Officer, Assistant Materials Officer, Quality Assurance Officer, and Port Logistics Officer for COMSUBGRU EIGHT supporting Sixth Fleet submarine operations in Europe and Africa.

CDR Shea is authorized to wear the Meritorious Service Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal and various individual unit and service awards. He earned a Bachelor's Degree in Nuclear Engineering Technology from Thomas Edison State College.
