Gentlemen:

Reference is made to subject contract between your company and the United States of America which is represented for that purpose by the Bureau of Ships, Department of the Navy.

Pursuant to a reorganization within the Department of the Navy effective 1 May 1966, the Naval Ship Systems Command has become the successor to the Bureau of Ships and the functions formerly exercised by the Bureau have been transferred to the said Command which will hereafter have cognizance of the subject contract.

Accordingly, the subject contract, as amended and supplemented, is hereby modified in the following respects to reflect said administrative change:

1. By deleting therefrom the term "Bureau of Ships wherever it appears in said contract and all reference to said Bureau, and substituting therefor the "Naval Ship Systems Command".
2. By deleting therefrom the "Chief, Bureau of Ships" wherever it appears in said contract and all reference to said Chief, Bureau of Ships, and by substituting therefor "Commander, Naval Ship Systems Command".
3. Except as herein modified the subject contract as amended and supplemented shall continue in full force and effect.
