1. Purpose. To provide instruction for reporting data on employment in private shipyards.
2. Cancellation. This instruction supersedes and cancels NAVSEA Instruction 4350.1 and the 10-74 edition of form NAVSEA 4350/2.
3. Action
 - a. Form NAVSEA 4350/2 is to be prepared and submitted monthly for all private shipyards and boat yards under the cognizance of the SUPSHIP. The report must be submitted in duplicate no later than fifteen days following the end of the reporting period to the Commander, Naval Sea System Command (SEA 0713) Washington, D.C. 20362.
 - b. An explanation of information desired in each column is given below. Provide average number of direct employees under each category for the reporting period.

- Column 1 - Private Shipyard (Name and Location)
- Column 2 - Direct and Indirect/Total Yard (The total number of employees on the payroll during the month)
- Column 3 - Engineering - Navy (Engineering required to support all Navy work)
- Column 4 - Engineering - other (Engineering required to support Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, Marad, Military Sealift Command and private sector work other than Navy)
- Column 5 - Navy Shipwork (New Construction and Conversion)
- Column 6 - Navy Shipwork (Repair, Ship alteration and etc. other than New Construction and Conversion)
- Column 7 - MARAD (New Construction and Conversion)
- Column 8 - Other Government (New Construction and Conversion for Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, Military Sealift Command and etc. other than MARAD New Construction and Conversion)
- Column 9 - Other Government (Repair and other shipwork for Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, Military Sealift Command and etc.)
- Column 10 - Private Shipwork (New Construction and Conversion)
- Column 11 - Private Shipwork (Repair and other Shipwork)


Column 12 - Other Sources (all non-Shipwork Production)
Column 13 - Absenteeism (Total Number Indirect Employees)
Column 14 - Absenteeism (Total Number Direct Employees)
