1. Purpose. To announce the transfer of the Naval Technical Representative Office (NAVTECHREP) from Commander, Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (COMSPAWAR) to Commander, Naval Sea Systems Command (COMNAVSEASYSYSCOM); and to publish the mission, functions and tasks to be performed by the NAVTECHREP as required by references (a) and (b).

2. Mission. To provide government representation at the Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Laboratory (JHU/APL) for Department of the Navy contracts; to provide program management, technical liaison and direction on behalf of COMNAVSEASYSYSCOM and other sponsors of research, development, test and evaluation efforts at JHU/APL; to represent and provide support to COMNAVSEASYSYSCOM and Program Sponsors in executing their roles as Primary Sponsor and tasking activities at University Affiliated Research Centers, and to perform such other functions and tasks as may be directed by higher authority.

3. Status and Command Relationships. NAVTECHREP is a shore activity in an active (fully operational) status. The chain of command and other organizational relationships are as follows:

## **FUNCTIONS AND TASKS OF NAVAL TECHNICAL REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE, LAUREL, MD**

1. Provides program management, technical liaison and program direction specifically delegated by Navy sponsors of Research, Development, Test and Evaluation (RDT&E) efforts at JHU/APL. This may include:

- a. Exercising final technical authority, including decisions affecting design, reliability and trade-off in design because of cost, performance or schedule considerations.
- b. Approval of specifications and modifications to test plans.
- c. Technical guidance in source selection of subcontractors.
- d. Technical approval of changes involving design, cost, and supplemental agreements.
- e. Periodic assessments of JHU/APL program and/or project status.

2. Supports Commander, Naval Sea Systems Command and other DOD organizations in executing their roles as contract sponsors and tasking activities, respectively, at JHU/APL.

3. Provides Government technical representation at JHU/APL for Department of the Navy contracts. If specifically authorized in writing, NAVTECHREP, Laurel will execute the assigned duties and responsibilities of Contracting Officer's Representative (COR).

4. Provides technical support and Navy liaison to the Defense Contract Management Command [DCMC], Baltimore.

5. Provides administrative support for DOD visitors to JHU/APL.

6. Assesses and determines technical necessity for document requests submitted by JHU/APL.

7. Conducts surveillance of the on-site Naval Communications and Technical Publications library.

8. Administers the Navy Technical and Government Identification card program for JHU/APL personnel, including conducting security training/briefs and issuing cards.

9. Certifies "need to know" for technical data and authorizes release of classified and technical information.

10. Represents the Director, University Laboratory Business Office (SEA OOU) on-site at JHU/APL and at other University Affiliated Research Center sites, as directed.
