Subj: PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING INFORMATION FOR SUPERVISOR OF SHIPBUILDING ORGANIZATION AND KEY PERSONNEL INDEX

Ref: (a) SECNAVINST 5211.5D of 17 July 1983, Department of the Navy Privacy Act (PA) Program

1. Purpose. To describe procedures for submission and maintenance of information for the Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Conversion and Repair, USN, Activities Organization and Key Personnel Index (SUPSHIP Index).

2. Cancellation. NAVSEAINST 5300.1C of 9 May 1985.

3. Information

a. Information provided in response to this instruction will be compiled and issued as the SUPSHIP Index. It will assist Navy personnel in their day-to-day operations; eliminate the need for each SUPSHIP to provide similar information to other SUPSHIPS; provide the Naval Sea Systems Command Headquarters offices with a ready reference of all SUPSHIP key personnel and organizational components; and, provide the NAVSEA Watch Office with a complete locator listing.

b. The Index will be published annually on 1 October each year and will be available to DOD components on a need-to-know basis only. Special editions of the Index will be made available as-needed. The SUPSHIP Index is a Distribution Statement "E" document.

4. Action

a. Form NAVSEA 5300/1 must be received by the Commander, Naval Sea Systems Command (SEA 071S) by 1 August each year. SUPSHIPS may use computer generated forms which replicate form NAVSEA 5300/1.

b. Only home telephone numbers for the Supervisor and Deputy Supervisor are required to be reported for use in the SUPSHIP Index. Home phone numbers for Department Heads and other key personnel are encouraged but not required. Information will be obtained using NAVSEA 5300/1 and will be transferred to form NAVSEA 5300/1. The Key Personnel Data form, NAVSEA 5300/3, will be maintained at each activity in accordance with the procedures set forth in reference (a).

c. The remarks section of the NAVSEA 5300/1 form should include facsimile machine phone numbers as well as Duty Officer phone numbers or procedures to be used to get in contact with the Duty Officer outside of normal working hours.

d. The SUPSHIP Index must be marked "**FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY**" and contain the following caveat:

Distribution Statement "E": Distribution limited to DOD Components Only. Contains personal information exempt from mandatory release under 5 USC 552(b)(6) . Requests for this document must be referred to NAVSEASYSKOM (SEA 071).

5. Request for SUPSHIP INDEX. The Index will be distributed by bulk mailing to Navy activities on a need-to-know basis. Refer all other requests for copies to the Commander, Naval Sea Systems Command (SEA 071).

6. Report and Forms. Report symbol NAVSEA 5300-1 is assigned to the SUPSHIP Index. This report is approved for a period of three years from the date of this instruction.
