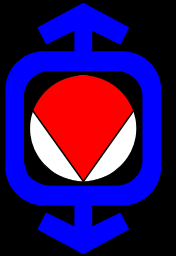

6. Continuously **improve** the Association's **value** to its members and the community



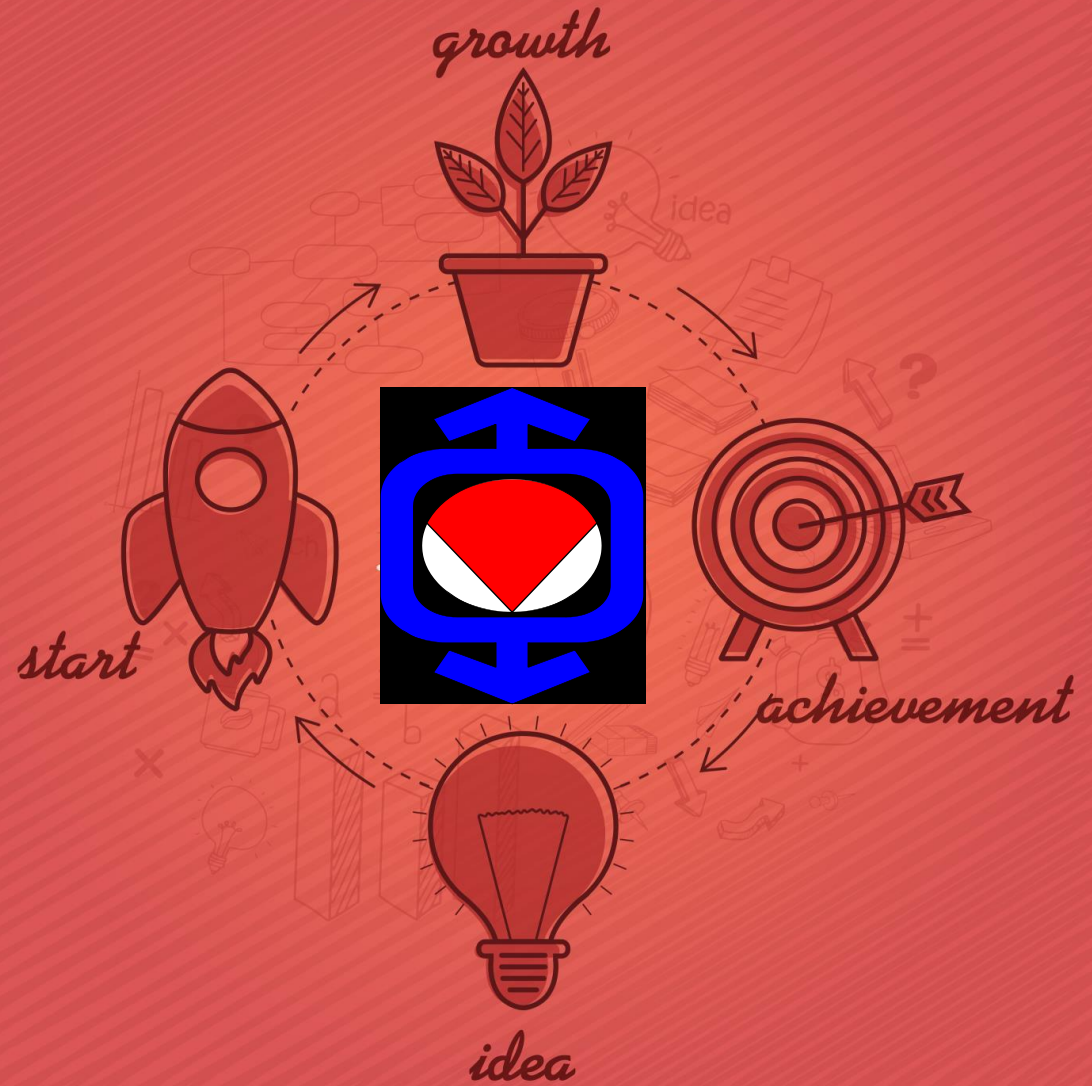
SAFE....

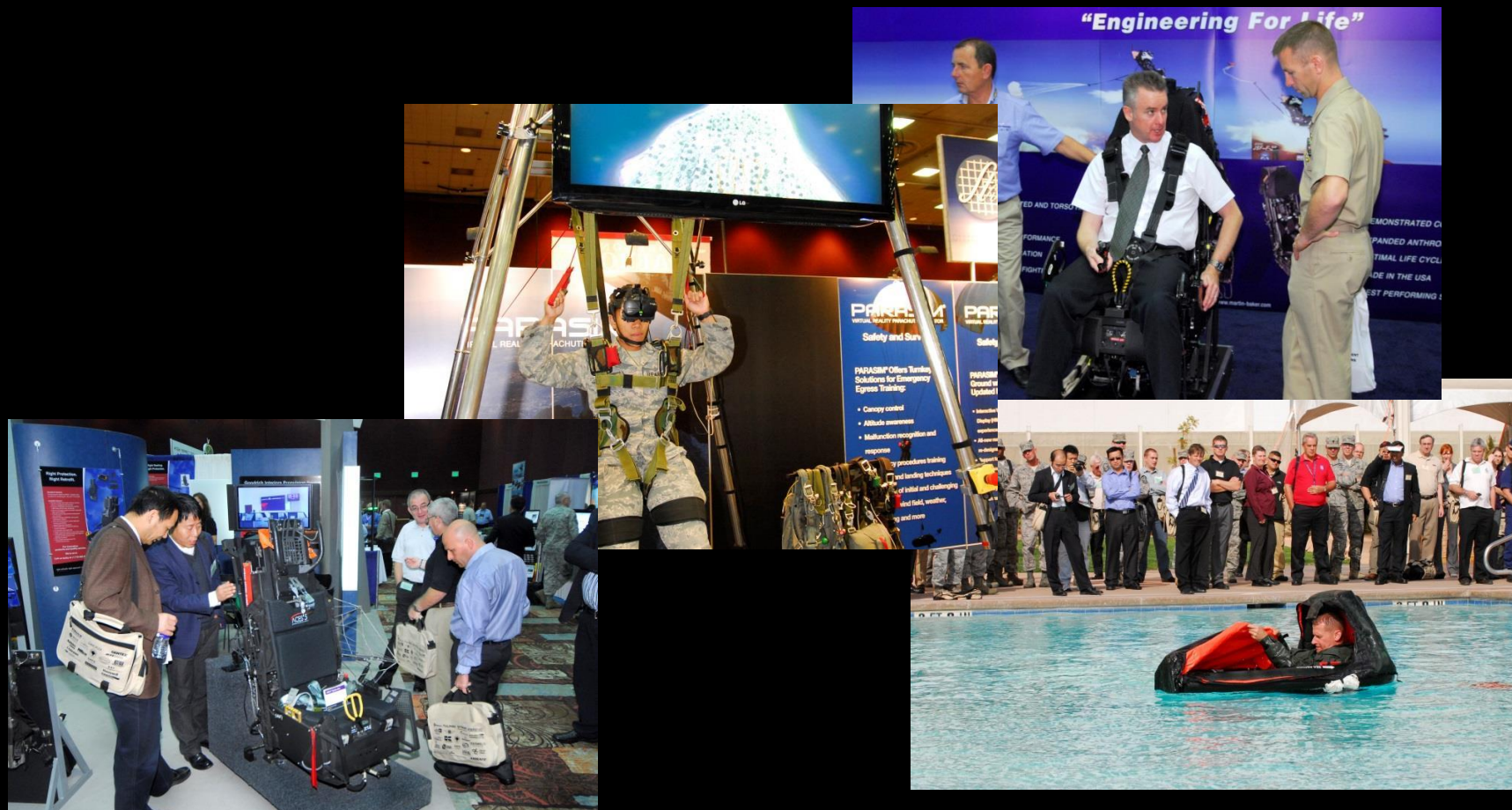
