Subject: NSWCPD Industry day held 11/16/22. Responses to questions from industry during event.

1. Will Code 10 upcoming procurements will they be issued in SeaPort or SAM?

The "future" contracts presented today in Department 10's slides will be posted in SAM as they are not SeaPort Contracts. Future contracts for 104 and 107 will be posted to SeaPort once the follow-ons are prepared for.

2. What is the anticipated scope of the C30 Cyber Engineering effort? Does it include risk management framework work?

Yes. The scope of this requirement includes RMF and engineering support related to cyber.

3. How do you decide whether an acquisition needs to use best value criteria vs. pass fail for Past Performance?

This is determined based on the requirement. Past Performance can be a PART of a best value criteria. Evaluation Type: Best Value (tradeoff) or Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA). Factors under Best Value: Past Performance, Corporate Experience, Key Personnel, etc.

4. Code 30 presentation showed FY22 requirements. Are there projections for FY23?

Code 30 presentation had an administrative error- all the requirements on slide 53 are FY23. This has been corrected in the posted version of the presentation.

5. Can you please let us know who currently maintains the Architectural/Engineering Design Services contract for the Infrastructure Division? Is this a Small Business set-aside contract? Will there be a Sources Sought before it is solicited?

There is no current A&E services contract. No package has been submitted to 02 Contracts yet - the determination as not been made if it will be a small business set-aside or if a sources sought will be issued prior to solicitation.

6. Who is the proper Tech Authority or PM we should reach out to discuss new Lithium battery chemistry and the approval process to get it on ships?

C/30 currently has requirements in FY23 for the refurbishment/Manufacturing of Lithium battery enclosures that house lithium batteries.
