requirements

- Provide proof of U.S. citizenship
- Obtain and maintain a security clearance
- Be at least 18 years old Enrolled/accepted for enrollment and in good academic standing in a degree-seeking program
- Enrolled in classes at least half time as defined by academic institution you are attending
- Ácademic institution must have an established co-op program
- Minimum 2.5+ cumulative GPA
- Engineering majors must be enrolled in ABET accredited program
