Dear Applicants, Parents, and/or Guardians

The Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC), invites you to apply for the Undersea Technology Apprenticeship Program. The Department of the Navy and NUWC Newport's goal is to support the development of the next generation of scientists and engineers through innovative and applicable educational incentives. NUWC's Educational Outreach Program introduces students to the wonders of engineering and spark young imaginations into innovation.

The Undersea Technology Apprenticeship Program (UTAP) is a 3-week paid part-time apprenticeship program. During the program students will apply concepts from Physics, Robotics, Engineering and Design to build, code, and pilot a Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) capable of overcoming real world challenges in a maritime environment. The apprenticeship consists of collegiate level lectures delivered by a university Professor; lectures cover topics such as Engineering, Programming, and Signal Processing, and technical skill building such as soldering, fabrication, and wiring.

There will be 2 sessions offered in the Summer of 2024. Availability is limited to 25 learners per session; New applicants will be given priority over previous UTAP participants. To be considered for this opportunity students must be under 18 years of age for the entire program, be a citizen of the United States, and be a rising sophomore, junior, or senior. All applicants are expected to adhere to all safety guidelines and directives, noncompliance will lead to expulsion from the program and no stipend will be awarded. Please see the attached code of conduct.

Please complete the attached application by 30 April 2024. Applications received after this date will not be considered. All application materials must be included for a student to be considered for this opportunity. Students must provide a UTAP Recommendation Form from a Teacher or equivalent (Non-Parent), Transcripts, and 3 writing samples. Any application received with missing materials will be returned or not considered. Please send all materials via email as PDFs.

- 4) Three essays (minimum 400 words per-essay) in one document that address the following topics:
 - a) Describe the benefits and challenges of working within a group on a project. (Include at least one strategy for overcoming one of the challenges)
 - b) Describe a recent technology that you have found interesting and impactful (to you personally or the greater world).
 - c) Describe why you want to participate in UTAP, and what you hope to gain from the experience.
