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






Q1:

Will you be using SeaPort for non-Brooks Act services (under NAICS: 541310, 541320, 541330) to support your RDT&E facilities and related infrastructure? This work would fall under contract services - engineering services or program management services.

A1:

There is no standalone NXG requirement anticipated for facility related services, but pieces of facility related work may exist in Program specific NXG requirements. For overall Division facility work, we would anticipate those being done outside of NXG.

Q2:

We had great difficulty locating and/or identifying contract opportunities at NUWC (and other Navy locations) for our services. Can you recommend an office that we could reach out to in order to better identify opportunities in the area?

How can we effectively get better access to ongoing requirements with Engineering Staff?

How can we get better visibility into these emerging requirements?

Are there any additional ways we can work with the Navy in seeking industry partnerships for research, development, and testing of new technologies?

A2:

Primary mechanisms to access DIVNPT opportunities would be the NAVSEA Long Range Aquisition Estimate (LRAE), sam.gov, Seaport NxG, and NASA SEWP.

For R&D and testing of new technologies, DIVNPT has a Chief Technology Officer (CTO) and engagements with that office may be appropriate. DIVNPT also utilizes our Other Transaction Authority with the Undersea Technology Innovation Consortium (UTIC), so that may be an avenue for engagement (www.underseatech.org).

Q3:

What are the follow-on plans for the Seaport contract which is scheduled to expire in 2028?

Are there any planned system changes to the Seaport portal due to Electronic Procurement System conversion?

A3:

Field Procurement Offices are not involved in the Acquisition Strategy or Program Management of the SeaPort Program.

Q4:

Does NUWCDIVNPT have a standard policy that all KOs and CORs must follow regarding seeking permission for Overtime Premium when overtime is not bid initially on a proposal, to ensure compliance with FAR 52.222-2(b)?

A4:

Yes, our internal Acquisition Guide provides overarching guidance to Contracting Professionals on Overtime Premiums. Contractors are reminded to read the clause and if a specific question/circumstance arises, discuss the unique elements with the Contracting Officer.

Q5:

If Section L and Section M of a particular RFP have seemingly inconsistent or contradictory guidance, which section takes precedence?

A5:

There is no order of precedence between L and M, they serve two different purposes – L is instructions on how to submit an offer, M is how the Government will evaluate what is submitted. If any potential offeror sees an inconsistency between the two they should submit a question in response to the solicitation to clear up any ambiguity.

Q6:

Is Small Business Set-Aside Contracts and Small Business Goals considered Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) under the current administration and is NUWCDIVNPT going away from small business subcontracting due to the DEI requirements?

A6:

There has been no action that has removed FAR/DFARS/NMCARS Part 19 and we've received no indication that is happening. As of 14 May 2025, it is business as usual and we are still tracking to the socio-economic goals provided to us by NAVSEA HQ.

Q7:

Are Market Surveys and Sources Sought done on a case-by-case basis or is this a requirement of all NUWCDIVNPT requirements prior to release of a solicitation?

A7:

Acquisition Planning and Market Research is different for each requirement. Some differences may depend upon prior competition, general knowledge of marketplace, changes to a requirement, current socio-economic figures, etc...

Q8:

Can NUWCDIVNPT confirm that naming prime or subcontractor employees on ECRAFT is not a requirement?

A8:

It is not a current requirement, but CORs may ask for additional information to supplement /spot check invoice/E2 submissions as required.
