



# United States Navy Biography

## **CAPTAIN RICARDO G. "RICHIE" ENRIQUEZ EXECUTIVE OFFICER SOUTHEAST REGIONAL MAINTENANCE CENTER**

CAPT Ricardo G. Enriquez enlisted in the U.S. Navy in September 1986 and completed recruit training in Orlando, Florida. He graduated from Limestone College with an associate degree and Bachelor of Arts. In October 1999, he was commissioned as an ensign under the limited duty officer (LDO) program. In 2007, he graduated from the University of Arkansas with a Master of Science.

His enlisted assignments include USS Thomas S. Gates (CG 51), where he was a "plankowner" and completed the ship's first deployment and historical port visit to the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics; USS Holland (AS 32); Naval Consolidated Brig Charleston, and USS Kearsarge (LHD 3), where he was selected to senior chief petty officer and LDO.



Assignments since his commissioning include USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN 71); USS Kearsarge (LHD 3); USS Trenton (LPD 14); Commander, Expeditionary Strike Group 2; USS George H.W. Bush (CVN 77); HQ Commandant, United States Joint Forces Command; USS Dwight D. Eisenhower (CVN 69); Board of Inspection and Survey (INSURV); Branch Head for Navy Personnel Command (PERS)-414, LDO/CWO detailing; and most recently as Commanding Officer, Center for Surface Combat Systems Unit Great Lakes, IL.

Enriquez reported as Executive Officer, Southeast Regional Maintenance Center, Mayport, FL in August 2020.

His personal awards include the Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (fourth award), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (eight awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (three awards), and various campaign, unit, and service awards.
