CAPT Michael Klauer Executive Officer Southeast Regional Maintenance Center

CAPT Klauer enlisted in the Navy as a Firecontrolman in January 1989 and achieved the rank of Chief Petty Officer. His enlisted assignments include USS WISCONSIN (BB 64), USS BUNKER HILL (CG 52), AEGIS Combat Systems Center Wallops Island, and USS VICKSBURG (CG 69).

He earned his commission through the Limited Duty Officer program in 2002. After commissioning, he reported to USS SACRAMENTO (AOE 1), serving as Weapons Officer from October 2002 to July 2004. His next assignments were to USS NORMANDY (CG 60), serving as Systems Test Officer from November 2004 to May 2007, Naval Air Station Whidbey Island serving as Ground Electronics Maintenance Officer and Installation Security Officer from June 2007 to March 2009, USS OSCAR AUSTIN (DDG 79), serving as Systems Test Officer from May 2009 to September 2011, Board of Inspection and Survey (INSURV) from September 2011 to July 2013, Commander Logistics Forces Western Pacific, in Singapore, as Staff Ordnance Officer from July 2013 to July 2016, Navy Munitions Command Unit Okinawa from October 2016 to September 2019 as the Commanding Officer, USS GEORGE WASHINGTON (CVN 73) from February 2020 to June 2022 as the Combat Systems Officer, and Board of Inspection and Survey (INSURV) from July 2022 to July 2025.

CAPT Klauer's personal awards include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal (2 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (7 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (3 awards) and numerous other service and unit awards. His professional qualifications include Commander Command, Surface Warfare Officer, and Tactical Actions Officer.
