Cableway Assessment

- Ref: (a) COMFLTFORCOMINST 4790.3, (Series), Joint Fleet Maintenance Manual (JFMM) VOL VI.
 - (b) NAVSEAINST 9304.1E
- 1. <u>Purpose</u>: To establish procedures for cableway assessment / assist team composition and procedures.
- 2. <u>Background</u>: SERMC is capable of performing cableway assessment to satisfy JFMN requirements. This WFMN describes the responsibilities and procedures for scheduling and conducting cableway assessment.
- 3. <u>Procedures</u>: Cableway assessment requires coordination through the Ship Superintendent.
 - a. Ship's Force (S/F) shall:
- (1) Submit a 4790/2K (2K) for cableway follow-up assessments must be conduct within 12 months prior to a major or minor Chief of Naval Operations availability.
- (2) Notify respective ship superintendent of the ships' request for cableway assessment to coordination with C958 Outside Electric shop.
- (3) Provide names from Ship's Force personnel (E4 or above) from source ratings i.e. AE, EM, ET, EW, FC, FT, GM, GSE, IC, IT, STG AND STS.
 - (4) Provide require number of personal for assessment at a minimum. LCS-4 and DDG-6.
- (5) Must attend 5 days cableway assessment repair training Monday-Friday starting @0830 located in Electric shop classroom number 164B. Any absent will be dis-enroll from course.
 - (6) Must conduct shipboard practical training during the assessment.
 - (7) Must pass end of course exam for qualification.
- (8) Within 30 days of completion of the assessment, enter all unrepaired Category 1 discrepancies in Current Ship's Maintenance Project for corrective repair at the earliest opportunity.
- (8) Must ensure all uncorrected Category 2 or 3 items documented in ship's current maintenance plan (CSMP).

b. SERMC shall:

- (1) Provide training program for ship's personnel. Training of Ship's Force personnel will include classroom training before the assessment and shipboard practical training during the assessment.
 - (2) Locate, identify and categorize electrical cableway discrepancies on ship.
 - (3) Train Ship's Force to access, repair, and maintain shipboard cableway.
- (4) Provide daily report to Ship's Commanding Officer and Chief Engineer of all Category 1 items identified through respective ship superintendent within 24 hours.
- (5) Provide final report of Category 2 or 3 items identified to Ship's Commanding Officer and Chief Engineer upon completion of the inspection.
- (6) Upon completion of the assessment, submit a final report to the applicable Type Commander (TYCOM), info the (ISIC) and Regional Maintenance Center.
