

FDNF Workforce


- Production oversight workforce & supervisors




2. How long will I be overseas?

- *Your overseas tour is 3 years*
 - *Bahrain is 18 months or 24 months*
- *Some are invited to stay up to the 5 year limit*
 - *DoD limits overseas tours to 5 years*
- *Return Rights retained through 5 Years and may be extended by your home command*

3. What do I do with my “stuff”?

3. What do I do with my “stuff”?

*The Navy moves you, your family & your stuff –
“PCS”: Permanent Change of Station*

- *Temporary lodging & meals*
- *Travel to PCS station*
- *Household goods*
 - *To PCS station*
 - *Non-temporary storage*
 - *Express shipment*

4. How's the pay?

- *It's great, but different than in the states...*
- *You will be paid well*
- *You won't lose money*

Extra Pay and Allowances

- What do you get when overseas?
 - Post Allowance (TAX FREE) is not a direct % it is based on spendable income.
 - Differs by location (Examples are for a GS-12)
 - Naples **20%**
 - Rota **10%**
 - Bahrain **20% (about 10% of pay)**
 - Japan **25%**
 - LQA
 - Differs by location (Examples are for a GS-12)
 - Naples **\$43,200**
 - Rota **\$33,300**
 - Bahrain **\$47,300**
 - Sasebo **\$32,500**
 - Yokosuka **\$45,700**
 - Post Differential Bahrain Only **15%**
 - Sunday Premium Bahrain Only **25% = 2 hrs = 5% of 40 hrs (so it is 5% of base)**

So What Does This Mean

- Bahrain Costs
 - Average utilities **\$0 (Covered by LQA)**
 - Cable and Internet **\$0 (Covered by LQA)**
 - Commute Cost **\$50 (Gas and Auto miles month)**
 - Out Of Pocket Rent **\$0**
 - Total **\$50**
- Norfolk Costs
 - Average utilities **\$200**
 - Cable and Internet **\$100**
 - Commute Cost **\$400 (Gas and Auto miles month)**
 - Out Of Pocket Rent **\$1000**
 - Total **\$1700**

These represent low figures for Norfolk.

70K base pay in Norfolk: 80k -20,400(annual out of pocket) \$59,600 spending money

70K base pay in Bahrain: 91K -600(annual out of pocket) \$90,400 spending money

This means you have approximately 30K extra per year before OT.

 - *Great on-base DoD schools, K-12*
 - *Colleges on-base*
 - *Private schools off-base (English and Local)*
 - *In US? – Paid student travel once per year*

6. What about medical care?



Top 10 List: FAQs

6. What about medical care?

- *USCS may use on-base facilities*
 - *Both out in town and on Base require you maintain insurance or incur the full cost*
 - *Except in Bahrain, as Bahrain does not have a Military Hospital*
- *Good local facilities – translator provided*
- *Paid travel to us for unavailable major care when approved by BUMED*
- *You are required to manage your own insurance(fill out forms, mailing and follow up)*
- *At times all upfront cost are required to be paid by the employee*
- *Dental care is available at all location via different types of providers*

7. How far away will I be?

7. How far away are the areas?
- *A day or less away – by air all locations*
 - *Longer for some than others*
 - *All locations are convenient to airports*

 - *All locations have 5 days of home leave above your annual leave earnings*
 - *Bahrain has 10 Days earned per year*
 - *Able to carry 360 hours of annual leave*

“Overseas” Compensation

- ❑ Post Allowance (PAL)
 - For cost of living overseas
- ❑ Living Quarters Allowance (LQA)
 - Pays rent & utilities
- ❑ Foreign Transfer Allowance (FTA)
 - Temporary Lodging before you leave
- ❑ Temporary Quarters Subsistence Allowance (TQSA)
 - Until you find a house/apartment
- ❑ Miscellaneous Expense Allowance
 - Move-in expenses
- ❑ And more...

Additional Incentives

- ❑ Shipment/storage of Household goods (HHG)
 - Up to 18,000 lbs at government expense
- ❑ Paid travel for qualified dependents in school
 - One round trip to Japan per year
- ❑ Entitled to 360 hours annual leave carryover
 - Retainable after returning stateside
- ❑ Home Leave – 5 days per year
 - Used in the U.S. /territories only
- ❑ Renewal Agreement Travel (RAT)
 - Roundtrip travel to US for entire family
 - After 1st tour/3 years upon extending 5 years
