## PETS COMING TO JAPAN CHECKLIST TO ASSIST IN THE REQUIREMENTS

Important to ensure all forms and dates are correct to avoid the 180 day quarantine!

<ul> <li>Animal has been in country of export for at least 180 days.</li> <li>International Microchip- must be done before BOTH rabies vaccines.</li> </ul>

Previous Rabies Vaccine- Animal must be at least 90 days old Rabies Vaccine #1 date:
Current Rabies Vaccine- Must have been given at least 30 days after Rabies Vaccine #1 but no more than 1 year.
Rabies Vaccine #2 date:
After Rabies Vaccine #2: Rabies Titer Test (FAVN) Date of Rabies Titer Test: Titer results: (must be greater than 0.5 IU/ml)
Quarantine period of 180 days begins the date the rabies titer test was done. This test is good for two years as long as the rabies vaccines do not expire <u>– don't let your rabies vaccines lapse AT ALL or you wil need to start over!</u>
Day 180 is on (mm/dd/yyyy)
<ul> <li>1-11 months prior to arrival:</li> <li>DA2PP or DHLPPC (canine) vaccination date:</li> <li>Bordetella (canine) vaccination date:</li> <li>FVRCP (feline) vaccination date:</li> <li>Kennel reservation in Yokosuka/Sasebo at Paws and Claws Boarding Facility</li> <li>Arrange pick up from airport with FMAT</li> </ul>
At least 40 days prior to arrival (if flying commercially): Advanced notification for import submitted to Japan. Approval number for entry: Within 10 days of arrival:
<ul> <li>Health Certificate- MUST include USDA certification if not done by a military vet.</li> <li>Internal and External parasite testing/treatment</li> </ul>
Upon Arrival:

- Check your pet into the boarding facility on base.
  Check in at Base Veterinary Treatment facility within 72 hours of your arrival.
