

## 2020 SSRAC MEETING INFORMATION

**\*\* ACTION REQUIRED \*\***

1. The 2020 SSRAC meeting for review of proposed FY22 NAVSEA Standard Items will be held from 15-19 JUNE 2020, at the Virginia Advanced Shipbuilding and Carrier Integration Center (VASCIC, 2401 West Avenue, Newport News, VA, 23607). The first day of the meeting, Monday, will be for select subcommittees only. (This will be determined once all change proposals have been received and work load per subcommittee has been reviewed.)

2. There were some significant updates to the NAVSEA Standard Items (NSIs) made as a part of the Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) fragmentary order (FRAGO) Initiatives, and Checkpoint Reduction initiative, in an attempt to help reduce costs, and schedule. The emphasis for FY22 will be a continuation of these efforts to ensure accuracy and bid ability of all NSI's.

3. Milestone dates for the meeting are as follows:

a. 17 APRIL 2020: Cutoff date for attendee registration.

b. 17 APRIL 2020: Cutoff date for submission of Change Proposals to the SSRAC Coordinator.

c. 15 MAY 2020: SSRAC Coordinator to provide serialized copy of Change Proposals to each subcommittee

d. 16 JUNE 2020: Convene SSRAC meeting (General Assembly). Some subcommittees may start on 15 JUNE 2020 Pending workload in order to have time to review all NSI's by the end of the week.

4. Each participating activity (e.g., SWRMC, PSNS-IMF, NAVSEA 04, SUPSHIP Bath, Norfolk Naval Shipyard, VSRA, AMMA, SCA) is limited to 2 attendees per subcommittee. Industry representatives are encouraged to participate and provide advice but will not be allowed to participate in any decision making.

5. There will be more information to follow for catering services. No conference fee will be charged.

6. Attendees must be trade oriented and familiar with the SSRAC Program and objectives. Designated representatives should submit a registration form, using the attached Registration Request Form. Forms are also available on the SSRAC website at:

b. Please be sure to indicate whether the proposal is "Administrative" or "Technical" in nature, and whether or not there is a cost or schedule impact. Incomplete forms will be returned.

c. Submissions should be e-mailed to [ssrac@navy.mil](mailto:ssrac@navy.mil) . The SSRAC Coordinator will take action on minor administrative changes, but all "major" proposals will be assigned a SSRAC Number and will be referred to the appropriate subcommittee for action.

**CHANGE PROPOSALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE 17 APRIL 2020 MILESTONE FOR PROPOSAL SUBMISSION.**

8. The subcommittees review proposals on issues relating to their technical/trade specialties and provide recommendations to the Steering Committee with supporting rationale. The Steering Committee acts on the recommendations of the subcommittees and handles issues that either cannot be resolved by the subcommittee or are beyond the scope of any one subcommittee.

a. The subcommittees of the SSRAC are:

- Environmental/Safety/Health
- Hull/Preservation
- Machinery/QA
- Piping/Boiler
- Electrical/Electronics
- 4-E/Phraseology
- General (non-trade-specific issues)
