- 3.1.1 Accomplish additional PCMS material handling and storage requirements in accordance with 2.2.

#### (V) "ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS"

3.1.2 Verify the environmental requirements of Section 3.1 of 2.1 are met prior to application of primers, tiles, caulking, and paint.

- 3.1.3 Verify the fairing of weld seams is in accordance with Section 3.3 of 2.1.(V)(G) "FINAL INSPECTION"
- 3.1.4 Accomplish a final inspection of newly installed PCMS material to verify correct installation.
- 3.1.5 Accomplish surface preparation and preservation for topcoat of new PCMS material in accordance with Section 3.2 of 2.1.
- 3.2 Accomplishment of cleaning and painting for new and disturbed surfaces must be in accordance with NAVSEA Standard Items (See Note 4.1).

# 4. <u>NOTES</u>:

4.1 If cleaning and painting for new and disturbed surfaces are required; the use of Category II NAVSEA Standard item 009-032 "Cleaning and Painting Requirements; accomplish' of NAVSEA Standard Items will be specified in the Work Item.
