

STANDARD WORK CENTER CODES FOR NAVY INFORMATION FORCE COMMANDS (NAVIFOR)

NOTE: NAVIFOR utilizes a coded work center assignment table across its commands to standardize the operations and maintenance within NAVIFOR. Utilize the below table to determine the four letter standard work center code.
